HLT stands for Health, Learning and Safety (or Hälsa, Lärande och Trygghet in Swedish) and is a partnership between the healthcare sector, preschools/schools and social services. The aim of the partnership is to combine forces so we can rapidly provide the best possible support to children and families who find themselves in need of assistance.

Many families need a little extra support now and then to make their lives more manageable.

Maybe things are not going as well as they should at preschool/school or your child is having problems with friends. Maybe there are difficulties within the family that are affecting your child.

Children reveal something is not right in different ways, like getting angry or sad, having a headache or stomachache, or showing signs of stress or anxiety. As a parent, it is easy to feel both despair and frustration that your child is not getting on well.

It is common for families to find themselves in this sort of situation from time to time. Parents often think they should be able to manage the situation themselves and have a hard time accepting help from people outside the family.

But experience shows that the earlier a family gets help, the quicker they can achieve a positive change. HLT gives you the opportunity to get the support you need in your situation.

HLT is a partnership between the healthcare sector, preschools/ schools and social services and is like a family. Together, we create a team aimed at giving you the support you need.



How participation with HLT works – step by step


Anyone working at a preschool/ school or in healthcare or social services can engage HLT support after consulting with you first.

HLT begins with a short planning meeting to discuss what you and your family are looking for. Where a coordinated approach may be helpful, you will be invited to a meeting. At this meeting, we want to you to tell us what you are having difficulties with so that together we can work out what will help you.

With HLT, it is vital that you and your child take part in planning what we are going to help you with. During the meeting, we will write up a support plan for you to approve.

The plan may include parental support, family meetings, individual adjustments, treatments or other creative solutions adapted specially for you. We then follow up on plan together to help ensure things improve.
